Of these, 24 semester hours of coursework must be formally registered as Philosophy (PHIL) courses, 24 course hours must be at the 200 level or above, and 9 hours must be at the 300 level.

To be approved for graduation, all philosophy majors must submit at least 36 credit hours in philosophy or philosophy approved courses\* [with a grade of "C" or better], with the conditions specified above.\* Also, one Writing Intensive course (indicated by a "WI" in the course schedule) must be completed within the major.
