Students must complete at least 90 hours at Benedictine University with a minimum GPA of 2.8 overall and in the sciences. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 30 semester hours at Benedictine University to be considered an affiliate in the application process. Students must apply by December 1<sup>st</sup> to Hines V.A. affiliated hospital clinical education program. Only US Citizens may apply and enter the Hines VA program.

\*\*Students who may wish to attend graduate or professional school should take CHEM 242, and 243; 247 and 248; and BCHM 361 instead of the Introduction to Organic and Biochemistry courses.
