**The specialization courses may only apply to one business major. Please see your academic advisor if a specialization course is required for two business majors to identify an additional specialization course.

Business & Economics majors who elect to earn a second major in the Undergraduate Business Department must complete unique "specialization courses" for the second business major. Specialization courses may only be used to satisfy the requirements for one business major.
