BENEDICTINE UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

COMMON CORE/Cultural Heritage courses = 6 semester hours to be taken at Benedictine University

COMMUNICATIONS = 9 semester hours. Take English 101, 102 and 103. Take Speech 100.

MATHEMATICS = 3 semester hours. See the Math listings on page 7.

Select IAI general education courses for the following three areas:

The College of DuPage IAI general education courses are in bold print starting on page 2.

HUMANITIES = 12 semester hours: For transfers with 20+ hours: 4 courses with at least 1 but no more than 2 courses in FNAR/MUSI, and one in PHIL/RELS/LITR. The remaining two courses are to be chosen from COMM, FNAR, FRLG, HIST, LITR, MUSI, PHIL, RELS, HUMN.

SCIENCE = 9 semester hours: Minimum of one course each of life science, physical science.

SOCIAL SCIENCE = 9 semester hours: Psychology or Sociology, Anthropology or Political Science, Economics or Business

****NOTE: If you are following the IAI complete program for your AA/AS, you need to see your College of DuPage advisor. The *itransfer.org* website has additional information.**

No more than 6 semester hours within a single program area may be used to fulfill the divisional core requirements. At least 9 semester hours must be completed outside the student's major program area for each divisional core requirement. **Divisional core (general education) requirements may vary depending on the major you select** and some of the courses can be used toward major requirements. *Please contact a Benedictine Transfer Counselor for assistance (630-829-6300).*

At least 55 semester hours of the 120 semester hours required for graduation must be completed at a four-year regionally accredited college/university.

A major field of study requires at least 36 semester hours, of which a minimum of 24 semester hours must be completed at the 200-level or above, of which at least nine semester hours must be at the 300-level or above. At least the final 45 semester hours* must be completed at Benedictine University including at least 12 semester hours at the 200-level or above in the major.

*Thirty semester hours for students accepted into the Degree Completion Program which requires a minimum of 75 transferable semester hours. The 55 rule above still applies. See the Benedictine Catalog on line for rules for the Degree Completion Program and the Accelerated Adult Evening and Weekend Programs.

Most courses at Benedictine are three semester hours. Science lab courses and some math courses are four semester hours. The conversion of quarter hours to semester hours is as follows:

5 quarter hours = 3.33 semester hours
2 quarter hours = 1.33 semester hours

4 quarter hours = 2.66 semester hours
1 quarter hour = 0.66 semester hours

3 quarter hours = 2.00 semester hours

KEY: SH or sem hr = semester hour. H = Humanities general education core. F = Fine Arts general education core. HF = Humanities/Fine Arts general education core. SB = Biological Science general education core. SP = Physical Science general education core. SS = Social Science general education core. EM = EL in major (limited). EL or Elective may satisfy some requirements in core, major, or minor. GE or General Elective only counts toward the 120 hours needed for graduation. TBD - to be determined.
