



It is always important to credit the books, journal articles and web resources you use in your research.

RefWorks is a web-based bibliographic management tool. You can use it to:

- Format bibliographies and citations automatically while you research in a variety of styles (MLA, APA, Turabian, etc.)
- Create and organize a personal research online database online
- Access your information online from any computer, anywhere
