


WRIT 101: Library Instruction Session Searching for journal articles in the Benedictine University Library

Begin your search on the library web page: <http://www.ben.edu/library>

I. Looking for a particular journal title.



Enter the title of the journal or newspaper in the space provided.

Here is how you would find the **New York Times**:

The library has it on microfilm from 1851-2007. This is the call number.

from 06/01/1980 to present in [LexisNexis Academic](#) and [ProQuest Newsstand \(Complete\)](#)

You have online electronic access from 1980 to the present. Just click on one of the database titles to connect.

II. Looking for databases in a particular subject area.

Click on Links to electronic resources by **subject**.

Select a subject area that relates to the topic you wish to research.

Select a database to search for articles on your topic.

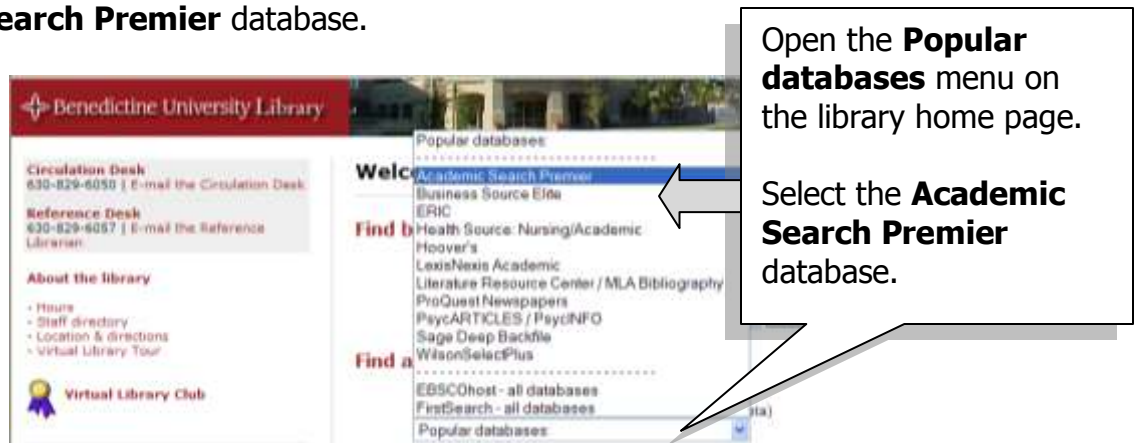
Database	Description
PsycARTICLES / EBSCOhost	Covers more than 40,000 articles from 53 journals - 45 published by the American Psychological Association (APA) and 8 from allied organizations.
PsycEXTRA / EBSCOhost	PsycEXTRA, produced by the American Psychological Association (APA), is a bibliographic and full-text companion to the scholarly PsycINFO database. The document types included in PsycEXTRA consist of technical, annual and government reports, conference papers, newsletters, magazines, newspapers, consumer brochures and more. It contains more than 150,000 records that are not indexed in any other APA database.
PsycINFO / EBSCOhost	Covers the professional and academic literature in psychology and related disciplines including medicine, psychiatry, nursing, sociology, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, and other areas. Coverage is worldwide, and includes references and abstracts to over 1400 journals and dissertations in more than 30 languages, and to book chapters and books in the English language.

The databases are listed in alphabetical order. Read through the list to determine which database(s) may be the most useful.

Hint: Visit, call, or e-mail the Reference Desk for help in selecting the most helpful databases.

III. Academic Search Premier is a good starting place for general research in all subject areas.

Open the **Popular databases** menu on the library home page to access the **Academic Search Premier** database.
