



Seeking experienced and academically qualified professionals to teach evening courses in the adult learner programs leading to:

- Master of Educator (MEd), which leads to Illinois certified as a Reading Specialist or a School Administrator;

These courses are typically five weeks in length and are offered at various sites within a 50 mile radius of Naperville campus, which include Chicago, Berwyn, Grayslake, Calumet City, Romeoville and Plainfield.

Requirements for Med. Program: 3-5 years of related work experience in reading or school administration.

Requirements for AABA, BAM, MBA and MPH Programs: 3-5 years of related business experience or clinical practice.

Requirements for all programs: Master's or Doctoral from an accredited college or university; familiarity with classroom management software (e.g. Angel or Blackboard) or a willingness to learn; experience with adult learners is preferred.
