TORNADO WARNING... TORNADO WATCH... DO YOU KNOW THE DIFFERENCE?



Most people are unaware that there is a difference between a watch and warning. A tornado **WATCH** means that *weather conditions are right to produce a tornado*. A tornado **WARNING** means that *a tornado has been sighted in the area and you should seek shelter immediately*.

Please take a moment to read and become familiar with the Emergency Response plan regarding severe weather and tornados.
