We further acknowledge that the permit will not be granted until all residents of the apartment have attended a required informational / educational session (or approved substitute) to review the alcohol policy and expected standards of conduct.

We understand that the issuance of the Alcohol Use Permit will be determined by the number, nature and severity of previous violations of any of the applicants. We acknowledge that Residence Life reserves the right to confer with University Police in the course of making a decision whether or not a permit application should be approved.
