Selected Listing of Various Editions of the Liturgy of the Hours

It seems best that oblates make use of the Liturgy of the Hours published in various editions. In this way, the oblate can become familiar with this form of prayer, which is prayed by the whole Church.

- *Morning and Evening Prayer: Selections from the Liturgy of the Hours*, ed. by Rev. D. Joseph Finnerty and Rev. George J. Ryan (NY: Regina Press, 1994), 307 pp.
 - one volume, hardback (paperback version out of print)
 - simplified one-week cycle of psalms, with special psalms for seasons of the Church year
- *Pray without Ceasing: Prayer for Morning and Evening*. Joyce Ann Zimmerman, C.P.P.S., et. al., (LP, 1993), 672 pp.
 - one volume, paperback
 - simpler structure than Roman Office
 - two-week series of psalms
- *A Shorter Morning and Evening Prayer: The Psalter of the Liturgy of the Hours* (LP, 1987), 562 pp.
 - one volume, very thin paper
 - also includes Night Prayer, Proper of the Seasons, Feasts of the Lord in Ordinary Time

- *Daytime Prayer—from the Liturgy of the Hours* (Washington, DC: U.S. Catholic Conference, 1978), 521 pp.
 - one volume
 - Midmorning, Midday, and Midafternoon Prayer, with Proper of Seasons, Solemnities of the Lord, Proper of the Saints

- *Shorter Christian Prayer* (NY: Catholic Book Publishing Co., 1988), 670 pp.
 - one volume, soft cover, thin paper, four-week cycle of psalms
 - Morning and Evening Prayer, with one-week cycle of Night Prayer
 - special selections for propers of seasons and saints

- *Christian Prayer: The Liturgy of the Hours* (NY: Catholic Book Publishing Co., 1985), 1600 pp.
 - one volume
 - includes four-week cycle of Morning and Evening Prayer plus Night Prayer; selections from Daytime Prayer; with Propers of Seasons, Propers of Saints, and Commons

- *Christian Prayer: The Liturgy of the Hours* (Boston, MA: The Daughters of St. Paul, 1976), 1758 pp.
 - hard cover
 - one volume, bonded leather, thin paper
 - includes Morning Prayer, Evening Prayer, Daytime Prayer, Night Prayer; and selections from Office of Readings; with Propers of Seasons, Propers of Saints, Solemnities

- *The Liturgy of the Hours According to the Roman Rite* (NY: Catholic Book Publishing Co., 1975)
 - four volumes, 1716 to 2044 pp. each
 - complete Roman Office

 - inclusive setting
 - one volume
