

RN to BSN Program Class Schedule

Delivered at College of DuPage August 2019 - August 2020 (Wednesday + select Mondays) 6 - 9:30PM

D2L access begins 7 days prior to the first session. All online courses begin on Monday and end on Sunday.

The ten nursing major courses (31 credits) plus one interdisciplinary seminar (IDS) to be completed in a 5-week MOD format over one calendar year, beginning August 2019. Program courses are in an accelerated and hybrid format (mix of on-ground/online) and include use of Desire to Learn (D2L) -online learning management platform. Additional out of class time of approximately 20 hours/week per course is required to meet learning outcomes. This work may include online individualized and group activities, reading, and assignments.
