Major Requirement Notes | All majors must submit at least 60 semester credit hours in major and

cognate courses (with a grade of "C" or better), of which 24 semester credit hours are at the 2000 level or above, including 15 semester credit hours at the 3000 level plus a study abroad experience. Math 1115 is also required.

① International focus approved by program faculty. At least 6 semester credit hours must be at the 2000 level or above.

② Approved International History course. Examples include Twentieth Century Europe, Modern Russia, Contemporary Latin America, Modern Middle East, Modern Eastern Europe or program faculty-approved History course.

③ Approved International Political Science course. Examples include International Relations, Model United Nations, International Political Economy or program faculty-approved Political Science course

An ethics course must be taken.

Program Requirement Notes | Students may be required to complete additional electives as part of their transfer degree requirements, degree completion and program agreement. Students may need to show proof of completion through degree conferral per program agreements. All students will need to fulfill the minimum requirement of 120 semester credit hours for this degree.
