Major Specific/Requirement Notes | All majors must submit at least 46 semester credit hours in the major. If a 2000-level transfer course is determined to be equivalent to an upper-level course at Benedictine University, an additional upper-level course may have to be completed in order to meet graduation requirements. Students who plan to major in two or more of the programs in the department (psychology, sociology, and/or criminal justice) must complete a capstone course for each major. Students have the following options: 1) Complete 4395 twice, one for each program 2) Complete 4395 for one program and an internship in the other program 3) Complete 4395 in one program and a research practicum in the other program.

4: CJUS 4351 Research Methods must be completed at Benedictine University.

5: May choose CJUS 4390 or 4395 if not already completed for the major requirements.
