 2: Students who are heritage speakers of Spanish (who grew up in a Spanish-speaking home) will take a Spanish elective in place of SPAN 2212.  
 3: Minimum ACTFL Ratings: Majors — Intermediate High level, and Minors — Intermediate Mid-level. It is highly recommended that students take the oral proficiency exam immediately after the study abroad experience, but students should arrange to take an oral proficiency exam during the semester prior to graduation at least.

 For BenU courses: Students with approved transfer coursework from four year institutions may require additional electives to meet program requirements.
